An ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING will be held **Friday, December 14, 2007, beginning at 9:00 a.m.**, in the Large Conference Room of the WV Health Care Authority, 100 Dee Drive, Charleston, West Virginia.

This hearing concerns District 1199's request for reconsideration of the Authority's Decision issued October 19, 2007, which approved the buyout of the Manor Care nursing home chain by the Carlyle Group.

You and any other "affected persons" as defined by W. Va. Code §16-2D-2 wishing to participate in the hearing of this application are directed to be present at both the prehearing conference and the administrative hearing.

The parties are directed to provide to the Authority and to exchange with all affected parties a list of witnesses and a summary of direct testimony that will be offered at the hearing, as well as copies of all documents that will be offered into evidence on or before **December 10, 2007**. **FAILURE TO PROVIDE** these items will result in a refusal to admit the proposed evidence unless good cause for the failure can be demonstrated.


