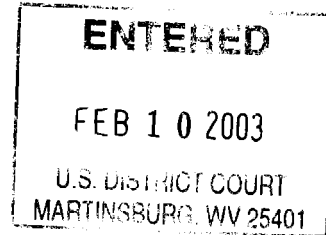

**ORDER**

The above styled matter is presently before the Court for consideration of several pending motions. The Court **ORDERS** the following:

1. The plaintiffs' second motion to amend and supplement the complaint is **DENIED.**<sup>1</sup> The Court has reviewed the issues presented by the parties and does not choose to reverse its prior ruling.
2. The plaintiffs' motion to extend time for service of summons and complaint is **DENIED.**<sup>2</sup>

4. The plaintiffs' motion for a protective order is **DENIED** as vague.<sup>4</sup>
5. The plaintiffs' motion to extend the expert disclosure and discovery deadlines, as well as vacate the June 10, 2002 scheduling order is **GRANTED**.<sup>5</sup> The parties are **ORDERED** to appear before the Court on **Monday, March 24, 2003, at 11:00 a.m.** for a scheduling conference.
